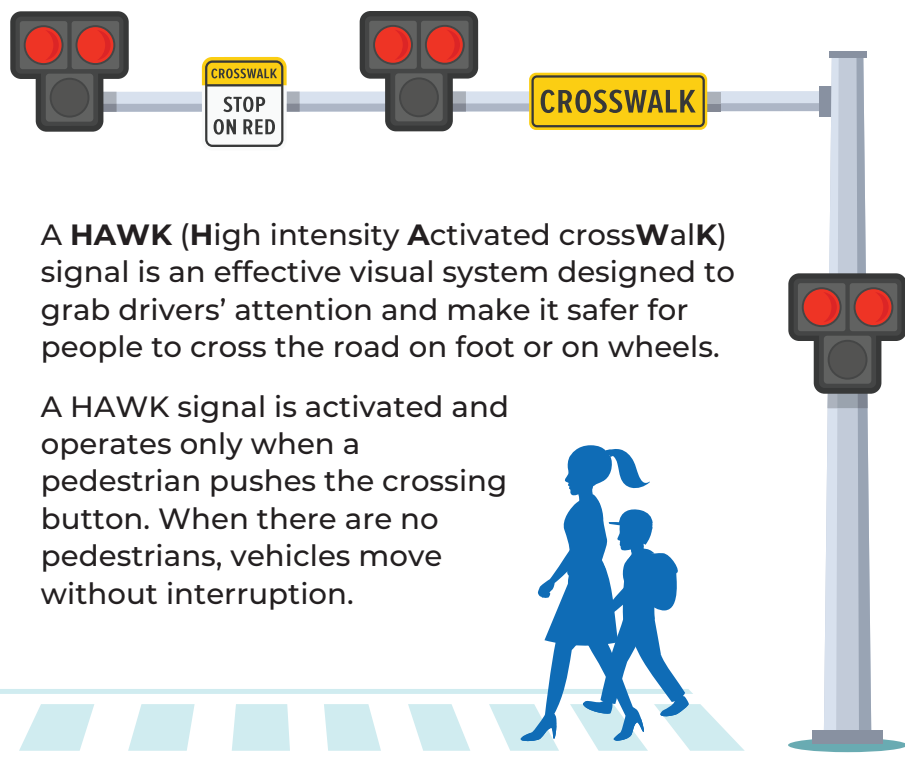

HAWK Signal Installation

What is a HAWK signal?



A **HAWK** (**H**igh intensity **A**ctivated cross**W**alk) signal is an effective visual system designed to grab drivers' attention and make it safer for people to cross the road on foot or on wheels.

A HAWK signal is activated and operates only when a pedestrian pushes the crossing button. When there are no pedestrians, vehicles move without interruption.

New HAWK signals will be installed at 7 different locations within the project:

George Washington at:

- Newton St.
- Urban Greenbelt Trail south of Guyer Ave.
- Mid-block at Uptown Shopping Center

Jadwin Avenue at:

- Mid-block at Uptown Shopping Center
- Kadlec Way
- Mansfield Ave.
- Mid-block south of Lee Blvd.

The Downtown Loop will create a more vibrant, welcoming place that supports local businesses and encourages people to connect.

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
